Estimados padres:

El libro que tenéis a continuación pretende lograr un repaso divertido de los temas de inglés fundamentales que vuestros hijos vieron durante el curso escolar recién terminado, y así consolidar dichos temas de una manera lúdica. Como bien sabéis, hablar una lengua extranjera como el inglés es una carrera de fondo. Todo el tiempo que se pueda dedicar a su práctica, en especial desde una edad temprana, es valiosísimo. En *Oxford Holiday English* tratamos de ofrecer actividades atractivas con contenidos muy medidos para que vuestros hijos no olviden lo aprendido y sientan en el inicio del próximo curso que son capaces de afrontar los nuevos contenidos, pues tienen una base sólida.

En este nivel hemos incluido una sección de gramática para cada unidad, donde los niños verán la explicación de un punto gramatical y tendrán algunos ejercicios para practicar.

Recomendamos que las actividades del libro se hagan con la ayuda o el control de los padres, aunque esto no es imprescindible. Las instrucciones del libro son sencillas y están en español, pero dada la corta edad de los niños, siempre es conveniente una pequeña ayuda.

Hemos creado este material para que se pueda utilizar de forma flexible en cualquier momento durante las vacaciones. Como veréis, el libro está dividido en unidades, y cada unidad consta de seis sesiones. Recomendamos que los niños hagan las sesiones de una en una para ayudarles (¡y a vosotros!) a comprobar cómo progresan. Cada vez que terminen una sesión, marcarán la casilla y encontrarán la pegatina correspondiente que pegarán en el calendario, en la fecha adecuada.

Además de las unidades principales, también hemos incluido historias que se pueden utilizar en cualquier momento, del mismo modo que las unidades. Las historias vienen acompañadas de actividades. Los niños también encontrarán en el libro una sesión de repaso con un crucigrama y un quiz. Marcarán la casilla y cogerán la pegatina, de igual forma que en las unidades principales.

En la última sesión de cada unidad encontraréis una pequeña actividad de manualidades adecuada para los niños. Os sugerimos que superviséis esta actividad.

A continuación incluimos un solucionario con el que podréis comprobar las respuestas de vuestros hijos. Esperamos que el libro sea de vuestro agrado.
